- Even, Lunch with Mr Clegg!

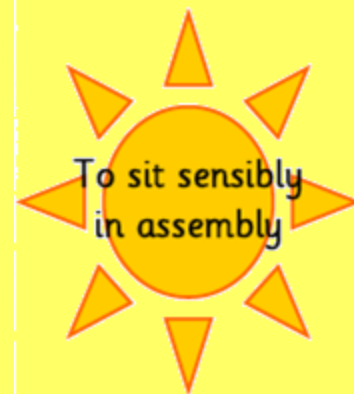
