


Thurlby CP School—Year 1

Term 3

Our topic this term is based around the book, 'Handa's Surprise'



English The children will continue to work with their Read Write Inc Phonics 4 times a week, where each child will be heard to read every day. We will describe the animals and fruit in Handa's Surprise, write a story map and retell the story and build and unscramble sentences. They will also compile a fact file on the Continents and Oceans of the World.

Maths

Children will compare numbers of objects up to 20 and continue to make number bonds to 20. We will add and subtract to 20 and count on and back. Year 1 will apply an understanding of addition and subtraction in worded problems. They will also use Ordinal Numbers for positions.

History / Geography

Year 1 will name and locate the world's 7 Continents and 5 Oceans using world maps, atlases and globes. They will compile a fact file with information on the Continents and Oceans.

PE

PLEASE NOTE - PE lessons will be held on Fridays. PE kits must be in school. Hair should be tied back and no earrings worn.

Science

Children will be identifying and naming a variety of common animals including fish, amphibians, reptiles, birds and mammals. They will name a variety of common animals that are carnivores, herbivores and omnivores. They will also describe and compare the structure of common animals.

Art / DT

During Art and DT, Year 1 will develop their skills using chalk, painting and sculpture.

RE

Year 1 will continue to read and discuss religious stories.

Reading Books

These are changed every Thursday. It would be wonderful if you could read these books with your child and discuss the books.

Children should be reading as much as possible to increase their fluency and to develop their love of reading. Don't forget to jot a note in the reading record diaries! Your child will also be heard individually by a teacher once a week. The day may be different each week.

Homework

This term we will be starting Homework challenges. These will be given out on a Friday and should be completed by the following Wednesday, where we will share the children's home learning together.
