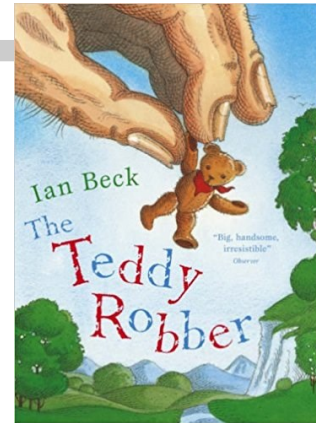


Thurlby CP School—Year 1

Term 5

Our Toys topic this term is based around the book, 'The Teddy Bear Robber'



English The children will continue to work with their Read Write Inc Phonics 4 times a week, where each child will be heard to read every day.

- Our book focus will be 'The Teddy Bear Robber' but we will also read other 'Toys' related books. We will be working on: leaving spaces between words; joining words and joining clauses using 'and,' beginning to punctuate sentences using a capital letter and a full stop, question mark or exclamation mark; using a capital letter for names of people, places, the days of the week, and the personal pronoun 'I'

Maths

Children will count to and across 100, forwards and backwards, beginning with 0 or 1, or from any given number. They will: count, read and write numbers to 100 in numerals; count in multiples of 2s, 5s and 10s; given a number, identify 1 more and 1 less; identify and represent numbers using objects and pictorial representations including the number line, and use the language of: equal to, more than, less than (fewer), most, least; read and write numbers from 1 to 20 in numerals and words. They will also: read, write and interpret mathematical statements involving addition (+), subtraction (-) and equals (=) signs; represent and use number bonds and related subtraction facts within 20; add and subtract one-digit and two-digit numbers to 20, including 0; solve one-step problems that involve addition and subtraction, using concrete objects and pictorial representations, and missing number problems such as $7 = ? - 9$

History

Year 1 will look at Toys of today, family favourites, 20th Century Toys, Victoria Toys and changes. They will investigate changes within living memory, the lives of significant individuals and historical events.

Science—Materials

Children will be distinguishing between an object and the material from which it is made; identifying and naming a variety of everyday materials, including wood, plastic, glass, metal, water and rock. They will describe the physical properties of everyday materials and will compare and group together a variety of everyday materials on the basis of their simple

Art / DT

During Art and DT, Year 1 will use a range of materials to design and make products. They will use drawing, painting and sculpture and develop a wide range of art and design techniques using colour, pattern, texture, line, shape, form and space.

Reading Books

These are changed every Thursday. It would be wonderful if you could read these books with your child and discuss the books. Children should be reading as much as possible to increase their fluency and to develop their love of reading. Don't forget to jot a note in the reading record diaries! Your child will also be heard individually once a week. The day may be different each week.

Music

Year 1 will learn new assembly songs, as well as music based around our topic of 'Toys'
